Children use the sounds within 2Sequence to create a composition (Unit 2.7 Lesson 1).  
They demonstrate their ability to manipulate digital content by editing and amending their composition (Unit 2.7 Lesson 1).  
They will have explored different sounds to utilise within their tune and functions such as tempo (Unit 2.7 Lesson 1).  
Children create, upload and use their own sounds as part of this (Unit 2.7 Lesson 3).  
Throughout this unit, children show that they can efficiently store and retrieve their work from their saved area on Purple Mash.

Children achieve all expected outcomes.  
In addition, using 2Beat, children can create a simple drum composition and export this as an mp3.  
They can then upload this into 2Sequence allowing them to add greater complexity to their composition.  
In doing this, children demonstrate their ability to seamlessly use all aspects of the software and therefore greater depth.  
Throughout this unit, children show that they can efficiently store and retrieve their work from their saved area on Purple Mash.
